Every day I see how your kindness and generosity impact Bethany residents. They share their gratitude for you with me when describing how much they enjoy their life at Bethany, or how they feel so well cared for here.

Sister Barbara Reney knew that she wanted to be a Sister of Saint Joseph from the time she was in grade school. She was the youngest member of her class of 47 women when she entered the congregation right after graduating from High School in 1950.

After studying English at Boston College, Sister Barbara's ministry began with her being assigned to teach 7th grade at St. Columbkille School in Brighton. She loved teaching and especially enjoyed teaching poetry to the children.



Reading and writing poetry were always part of the English lessons when Sister Barbara was teaching. She began writing poetry in grade school and has continued to write throughout her ministry. Sister Barbara's father frequently read poetry to her and her four siblings when she was young, and she can still recite some of these poems today. She believes there is a spirituality to poetry, and it can be used to express your connection to God.

Sister Barbara later went on to teach at Sacred Heart School in Weymouth, Mt. St. Joseph Academy, and Fontbonne Academy. Later in her ministry, Sister Barbara had the opportunity to study in California before beginning a new role leading retreats at the St. Joseph Retreat Center in Cohasset for 16 years.

But her days instilling a love for poetry in children weren't over. Sister Barbara joined the staff of Ursuline Academy in 2009 and soon found herself teaching 7th grade English again. Though retired and living at Bethany now, Sister Barbara is still writing poetry to this day. It certainly is no surprise that Sister Barbara penned an ode to Bethany to express her gratitude for all that you make possible.

I, along with every staff member here at Bethany, am so grateful for your investment in the lives of those who call Bethany home. **My sincere appreciation for your help.**


