That's where Kenzie "lived" – caged, sold to whoever came to the door with money.

Imagine Kenzie, believing she'd never get away. Absolutely hopeless.

And then she sees a chance to run – running for her very life – and escaping!!

But now what? Where does she go? Where can she be safe? Who would help – even know how to help – someone like Kenzie?
