Those are topics that are simple to talk about. However, today we find ourselves reaching out to you on a topic that is far from glamorous. In fact, it's a topic so many of us shy away from: sanitation and sewer systems.

Yes, that is the topic which we bring to you today. You see, Pamela, as our campus inches closer and closer to 100 years old, capital improvements rear their heads more and more. We have a sewer repair

scheduled to take place the beginning of October that will cost nearly \$32,000. Can you chip in to help make this important preventative repair?

You see, the main sewer line has begun to deteriorate and is nearing collapse in some areas. It is currently operational, but is becoming difficult to keep clear. This original sewer line was installed over 50 years ago and has lasted longer than expected.

Pamela, we don't want to wait until there's a BIG problem before making the repairs. Left unchecked, we could experience the backup of sewage into the school and office buildings; flooding in the lower level of buildings; and other issues related to raw sewage in the near future.
