Little Ty's journey to St. Jude began shortly after last year's family Easter egg hunt. Every time he bent down to grab an egg, he couldn't keep from falling over. "His balance was that bad," remembers his mom. So his worried parents took him to their hometown pediatrician and to their terror, scans revealed a mass the size of a small peach in Ty's brain.

Surgeons at their local hospital were able to remove the entire tumor, but when it came time to begin follow-up care, Ty's parents wanted "the best of the best" in care for Ty -- they wanted a place that could give them more hope. Their search led them to St. Jude.

At St. Jude, Ty's treatment for his brain cancer, anaplastic cpendymoma, includes 33 radiation treatments and four months of chemotherapy. He is also in physical therapy to regain strength and mobility post-surgery. "St. Jude has been amazing," says his mom. "We couldn't be happier with what they've done."

Without the support of friends like you, there would be no St. Jude for children like Ty. Because the daily operating cost at St. Jude is primarily funded by generous individuals like you who embrace our mission -- from the lifesaving care to the transportation.
