"Wow! An arrowhead!" I thought one afternoon when my wife Arlene and I were walking along the path that leads from our home to Hoque Creek This past spring we were enjoying the 70-degree weather out here in Frederick County, Virginia, when I looked down and saw an arrowhead in amazingly perfect condition.

Finding and holding this arrowhead got me thinking: "was it shot for practice? hunting food? or in anger? in which century?"

Lots of images came to me, along with a deeper sense of perspective. We are on Earth for a short time only. What will we leave to our grandchildren after we're gone? Money for relatives? Material wealth?

What about something that would benefit our community and bring joy to those who come after us... That's what Arlene and I wanted to leave for future generations. A way to forever protect the forests and creek on our property.

With Potomac Conservancy's help, we did just that. We permanently protected our land by putting a conservation easement on it, a legal process that ensures it can never be developed.

Three of our neighbors did the same, altogether totaling well over 500 acres of land – of forests, meadows, and creeks, protected forever. Taking care of this land will protect the water quality of Hogue Creek and the Potomac River downstream. That's a lasting gift to the future.

None of this would have been possible without people like you putting Potomac Conservancy to work protecting special outdoor places.
