Your generous and long-term support is what makes our field staff's humanitarian efforts possible. In the Democratic Republic of Congo's (DRC's) northeastern Haut-Uélé and Bas-Uélé districts, hundreds of women, children, and men have been brutally massacred in attacks by the rebel Lord's Resistance Army since December 2008. Some 190,000 people have fled their homes, according to the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees.

Doctors Without Borders is one of the only aid organizations delivering medical care to displaced people in this isolated region. "The situation is critical,"

said Amaury Grégoire, Doctors Without Borders emergency coordinator, in June. "Health structures are either nonexistent or in a deplorable state. There are few or no medicines available. The majority of local medical staff have fled the violence along with the rest of the population."

Doctors Without Borders has launched new programs to help the massive influx of displaced people. In the eastern town of Faradje, our field teams treat more than 1,000 patients a week, mainly for malaria, acute respiratory infections, and intestinal diseases, all of which, if untreated, can be fatal in an already weakened population. In the town of Niangara, our staff perform emergency surgery and treat victims of sexual violence. Our teams also provide medical and nutritional care, and distribute basic relief items, to more than 22,000 people who fled to neighboring Ituri province to escape the violence.


In a time of perilous medical crises and financial volatility, Field Partners are our most highly valued supporters.
