Together, over the past year we:

- Gave a warm, safe bed to 405 adults and children in the emergency shelter
- Helped 94 individuals and families achieve safe, permanent housing
- Answered 6,493 calls to the 24-hour crisis and support line, providing survivors with critical information, referrals, and other resources
- Assisted 298 adults with protective orders, applying for pro bono legal services, and other legal matters
- Empowered 11 women to move closer toward independence by staying at Harmony House, AWAIC's on-site transitional living facility
